Sealed tenders are invited from Members for the purchase of green leaf from the Association's plots at Nagrakata Sub Station, Nagrakata 735 225. The estimate of production for the season is 60,000 kgs. (approx.).

Terms & Conditions

1. A Security Deposit consisting of an Account Payee Cheque or Bank Draft payable at Kolkata for Rs. 50,000/- drawn in favour of Tea Research Association shall accompany each tender. The Cheque/Bank Draft will be returned to the unsuccessful Tenderer. In the event of a successful bidder not accepting the offer, the deposit shall be forfeited.
2. The successful Tenderer (Purchaser) shall have to pay an advance of Rs. 1,20,000/- (Rupees one lakh twenty thousand only) on receipt of the formal letter of acceptance of the offer to sell. Security Deposit shall be refunded to the Purchaser on receipt of the Advance. The "Advance" will not carry any interest and will be refunded at the end of the plucking season.
3. Weekly bills of supply of green leaf shall be raised at Nagrakata by Tea Research Association and sent to the Purchaser. Payment have to be made immediately on receipt of the bills failing which interest @ 12% per annum from the due date will be levied.
4. Expected minimum daily quantity will be 50 kgs. and the maximum is 300 kgs.
5. Leaf has to be collected on every working day from TRA Nagrakata between 3:30 pm and 4:30 pm (garden time).
6. Green leaf will be loaded and transported by the purchaser at his own cost.
7. If leaf cannot be collected on a particular day for any reason, 48 hours advance notice will be required to be given by the Purchaser to TRA.

8. The Purchaser shall depute a representative to be present during weighment to avoid any dispute. In case such representatives are not available at the time of weighment, TRA's weighment shall be final and any difference in weight at the receiving end shall not be taken into account.
9. Leaf will not be sold to any Member having outstanding membership subscription dues up to 31st December, 2009. The Executive Committee of the Association shall not be bound to accept the highest offer and reserves the right to amend or alter the terms and conditions of the Tender at any time.

Tender for Sale of Green Leaf from TRA Plot at Thakurbari : Season 2010

Sealed tenders are invited from Members for the purchase of green leaf from the Association's plots at Thakurbari. Leaf will be available for sale from the first week of April 2010 and estimated production for the season is 40,000 kgs.

Terms & Conditions

1. A Security Deposit consisting of an Account Payee Cheque or Bank Draft payable at Kolkata for Rs. 40,000/- drawn in favour of Tea Research Association shall accompany each tender. The Cheque/ Bank Draft will be returned to the unsuccessful Tenderer. In the event of a successful bidder not accepting the offer, the Deposit shall be forfeited.

For the successful Tenderer (Purchaser), the amount of Rs. 40,000/- shall be considered as Advance and shall be adjusted from each bill on pro-rata basis in such a manner that the amount shall be fully adjusted by September, 2010. The amount shall, however, not carry any interest.

2. Expected minimum daily quantity will be 50 kgs. and the maximum is 300 kgs.
3. Leaf has to be collected on every working day between 3:30 pm and 4:30 pm (garden time).
4. Green leaf will be loaded and transported by the purchaser at his own cost.
5. If leaf cannot be collected on a particular day for any reason, 48 hours advance notice will require to be given by the Purchaser to TRA.

6. Fortnightly bills of supply of green leaf shall be raised at Thakurbari by TRA and sent to the Purchaser. Bills shall have to be settled by Cheque/Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Tea Research Association", payable at Kolkata within 15 days of receipt of the bills. In default of payment of the bill amount within 15 days from the date of receipt of the bill, the Purchaser shall be liable to pay interest @ 12% from the due date till the date of payment.
7. The Purchaser shall depute a representative to be present during weighment to avoid any dispute. In case such representatives are not available at the time of weighment, TRA's weighment shall be final and any difference in weight at the receiving end shall not be taken into account.
8. During the season, Thakurbari will require about 400 kgs of Made tea for staff and labour. In lieu of, green leaf (1:4.5) will be supplied free of cost.
9. Leaf will not be sold to any Member having outstanding membership subscription dues up to 31st December, 2009.
10. The Executive Committee of the Association shall not be bound to accept the highest offer and reserves the right to amend or alter the terms and conditions of the Tender at any time.
11. In case of any dispute arising out of or in connection with the Agreement, the decision of the Council of Management of the Association shall be final and binding on the Purchaser.

3. The successful Tenderer (Purchaser) shall have to pay an advance of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakhs only) on receipt of formal letter of acceptance of the offer to sell. 7. Leaf that cannot be collected on a particular day for any reason shall be charged to the Purchaser's account unless 48 hours advance notice has been given to the Estate Manager at Tocklai in writing stating that it will not be possible to lift the leaf.
8. During the season TRA will require to be supplied with about 8000 kgs of Made tea for staff and labourers. For made tea supplied, green leaf will be adjusted @ 1:4.5. No extra charges on any account will be paid to the Purchaser.
9. The Seller on any day may retain up to 2000 kgs of the green leaf production but cumulatively not exceeding 10% of the actual annual production of Tocklai Division of Cinnamara Tea Estate. However, 24 hours notice will be given whenever the Seller wants to retain such leaf or part thereof.
10. In case the contract is terminated by the Purchaser, the unadjusted advance shall be adjusted by the Seller to realize all outstanding amount, if any, together with interest at 12% per annum and the balance amount, if any, will be forfeited. The Seller shall be entitled to terminate the agreement if the Purchaser fails to lift such green leaf for a period of two weeks or the Purchaser fails to make payment of the bills for two consecutive weeks, of the green leaf so purchased.
11. Leaf will not be sold to any Member having outstanding membership subscription dues up to 31st December 2009. The Executive Committee/Council of Management of the Association will not be bound to amend or alter the terms and conditions of the Tender at any time.
12. In the event that the Tocklai Division is returned to Assam Tea Corporation, this agreement shall stand terminated with effect from the date of transfer to Assam Tea Corporation.
